



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR PREVIOUS SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS FOR THE 2020 - 2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Delmar Foundation Scholarship provides scholarships to individuals who reside in the Franklin Regional School District (in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania) and need financial help to be able to attend an accredited college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school. The scholarship program is administered by a Scholarship Selection Committee, which will verify eligibility based on the scholarship criteria, select recipients, and determine the amount of individual awards. The maximum award is \$5,000 per student per school year. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, age, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PREVIOUS RECIPIENTS OF DELMAR FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

A previous recipient of a Delmar Foundation Scholarships who is reapplying must:

- Continue to be a permanent resident within the Franklin Regional School District in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania
- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident
- Demonstrate financial need to pay tuition and other school expenses
- Be enrolled in a degree or certificate program at an accredited college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school – on a full-time or part-time basis – and have achieved the following levels of academic performance:
 - Applicants completing their first (freshman) year must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale (or comparable performance on other grading systems) for the year
 - Applicants completing their second (sophomore) or third (junior) year must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale (or comparable performance on other grading systems), including the semester in which you are applying
- Not have exceeded the maximum number of years of eligibility, which is the number of years that is typically required to complete a degree or four years, whichever is less

Students pursuing graduate-level education, in the fifth or later year of a combined undergraduate/graduate program, and members of the Delmar Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, their spouses and children are not eligible.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

If you are a first-time applicant for a Delmar Foundation Scholarship, please complete the [Application for First-Time Applicants](#) available at DelmarScholarships.org.

1. Review the [eligibility requirements](#) to ensure that you still qualify.
2. [Register](#) at DelmarScholarships.org. (You, not your parent or guardian, must register.) This will allow you to download an application, ensure that we know who is applying for a scholarship, and enable us to communicate with you when necessary. If you registered previously, you may [log-in](#) with your existing User ID and password.
3. Complete or obtain copies of documents needed to apply, as follows:
 - Download and complete the application form (in this file). The application is a fillable PDF form and you should complete it electronically. (To be able to open and save information in the form, you will need to use the current version of [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#).) *Handwritten applications will not be accepted.*
Note: You must complete the application form yourself, without assistance from others (e.g., parents or guidance counselors). Any applicant who receives such assistance will be disqualified.
 - Obtain a copy of your transcript from the college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school that you are currently attending. (If your transcript does not include information for the current semester, you may submit an unofficial transcript with your application. If you receive a scholarship, we will require that you submit an official transcript with your tuition bill.)
 - Obtain a copy of your [Student Aid Report](#) (SAR), which will require you to complete a [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA). Please be sure to download the [full SAR](#), which is several pages long.

Note: It can take from three days to three weeks for a FAFSA to be processed. For more information on the FAFSA process, go to [FAFSA](#).

- Obtain a summary of your financial aid from the college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school you plan to attend or are currently attending. (If you are transferring to a different school, the FAS should be from the school to which you are transferring.) This Financial Aid Summary (FAS) must include a summary of:
 - Your cost of attendance for the upcoming school year
 - Your financial aid for the upcoming school year

If your FAS for the upcoming school year will not be available before the application deadline, you may submit your FAS for the current year, *noting any changes you expect to occur in the upcoming year*. (If you are selected for a scholarship, we will ask you to submit your FAS for the upcoming year before we finalize your award.)

- If you plan to live off-campus:
 - Obtain a copy of your lease or bill for off-campus housing costs. If you will not be responsible for the full amount of the rent, indicate what portion of the total will be your responsibility.
 - Estimate your portion of utilities (e.g., electricity, gas, and water) if they are not included in your rent
 - Estimate your cost for food not covered by a campus meal plan
 - Copy your current driver's license, voter registration card, or other government issued identification that shows your current address and can be used as proof of residency in the Franklin Regional School District.
4. Submit all of the documents listed above in one package and no later than 5:30 PM (EDT) on June 1, 2020. Documents submitted individually will not be accepted. You may submit your application package by:

5. When we receive your complete application package, we will e-mail a "Supplemental Financial Information" form to your parent(s)/guardian(s). Your parent or guardian should complete the form and e-mail it to applicantInfo@delmarscholarships.org no later than June 8, 2020.
