



SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS FOR THE 2020 - 2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Delmar Foundation Scholarship provides scholarships to individuals who reside in the Franklin Regional School District (in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania) and need financial help to be able to attend an accredited college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school. The scholarship program is administered by a Scholarship Selection Committee, which will verify eligibility based on the scholarship criteria, select recipients, and determine the amount of individual awards. The maximum award is \$5,000 per student per school year. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, age, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for a Delmar Foundation Scholarship, you must:

- Be a permanent resident within the Franklin Regional School District in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania for at least one year prior to the application deadline
- Be a U.S. citizen or a legal permanent resident
- Demonstrate financial need to pay tuition and other school expenses
- Be a high school senior, or have a high school diploma or General Education Degree (GED). You may have:
 - Attended the Franklin Regional School District
 - Been home schooled
 - Attended a private or parochial school
 - Been a member of a cyber charter school
- Have applied to or currently be enrolled in a degree or certificate program at an accredited college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school – on a full-time or part-time basis
- Have achieved a minimum high school cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.00 grade point scale or have received a GED. If you have been or are currently enrolled in a college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school, you must also meet the following requirements:
 - If you are completing your first (freshman) year, you must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale (or comparable performance on other grading systems) for the year
 - If you are completing your second (sophomore) or third (junior) year, you must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale (or comparable performance on other grading systems), including the semester in which you are applying
- Have been involved in a variety of extracurricular activities, volunteer activities, and/or work experiences

Students pursuing graduate-level education, in the fifth or later year of a combined undergraduate/graduate program, and members of the Delmar Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee, their spouses and children are not eligible.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

As a first-time applicant, you should:

1. Review the [eligibility requirements](#) to ensure that you qualify.
2. [Register](#) at [DelmarScholarships.org](#). (You, not your parent or guardian, must register.) This will enable you to download an application and recommendation form, ensure that we know who is applying for a scholarship, and enable us to communicate with you when necessary. If you registered previously, you may [log in](#) with your existing User ID and password.
3. Ask two people to complete recommendations for you. One recommendation must be from a teacher or guidance counselor, and the other from a member of the community (e.g., a family friend, neighbor, mentor, minister/priest, or someone you worked with on a community activity).
 - Download the [recommendation form](#), available on-line at [DelmarScholarships.org](#). (You will need the current version of [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) to be able to open and save information in the form.)

- Fill in your name and e-mail address on the recommendation form. (We will use your e-mail address to notify you when we receive your recommendations.) The recommendation form is a fillable PDF, so you should fill in your name and e-mail address electronically.
- Provide each of your recommenders a copy of the recommendation form with your name and e-mail address filled in. Please give your recommenders the electronic version of the form (fillable PDF), so they can complete the form electronically.
- Ask your recommenders to submit their recommendations by June 1, 2020. Recommendations may be submitted via e-mail to recommendation@delmarscholarships.org, with your name in the subject line or mailed to the address below, postmarked no later than June 1, 2020:

4. Complete or obtain copies of documents needed to apply, as follows:

- Download and complete the application form (in this file). The application is a fillable PDF form and you should complete it electronically. (To be able to open and save information in the form, you will need to use the current version of [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#).) *Handwritten applications will not be accepted.*

Note: You must complete this application yourself, without assistance from others (e.g., parents or guidance counselors). Any applicant who receives such assistance will be disqualified.

- Obtain an official copy of your high school transcript.
- If you are currently enrolled (full-time or part-time) in a college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school, obtain a copy of your transcript. (If your transcript does not include information for the current semester, you may submit an unofficial transcript with your application. If you receive a scholarship, we will require that you submit an official transcript with your tuition bill.)
- Obtain a copy of your [Student Aid Report \(SAR\)](#), which will require you to complete a [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#). Please be sure to download the [full SAR](#), which is several pages.

Note: It can take from three days to three weeks for a FAFSA to be processed. For more information on the FAFSA process, go to [FAFSA](#).

- Obtain a summary of your financial aid from the college, university, junior college, technical college, or trade school you plan to attend or are currently attending. (If you are already enrolled in college or another school, and are transferring to a different school, the FAS should be from the school to which you are transferring.) This Financial Aid Summary (FAS) must include a summary of:
 - Your cost of attendance for the upcoming school year
 - Your financial aid for the upcoming school year
- If you plan to live off-campus:
 - Obtain a copy of your lease or bill for off-campus housing costs. If you will not be responsible for the full amount of the rent, indicate what portion of the total will be your responsibility.
 - Estimate your portion of utilities (e.g., electricity, gas, and water) if they are not included in your rent
 - Estimate your cost for food not covered by a campus meal plan
- Copy your current driver's license, voter registration card, or other government issued identification that shows your current address and can be used as proof of residency in the Franklin Regional School District.

5. Submit all of the documents listed above in one package and no later than 5:30 PM (EDT) on June 1, 2020. Documents submitted individually will not be accepted. You may submit your application package by:
